



The above draught represents a copy of a survey made March 4th AD 1825 by my predecessor Mr. Law in pursuance of the actual settlement and improvement of John Boice bounded as above situate in Chippewa township Beaver County containing eighty nine acres forty three perches and the allowance of six per cent - which survey I return upon a warrant directed to said Law bearing date the 16th of July AD 1827 it appears not to be returned according to Law.
