



In Pursuance of an Application bearing date April 3rd 1769 No. 1337, Surveyed on the 10th day of September 1785 unto James Gully in Right of James Baird the above Described Tract of Land situate in Huntingdon Township Westmoreland County Containing Two Hundred Forty Eight Acres 1/2 & allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.

Note the above tract of Land was Surveyed by Captain John Henderson Deceased, and said to be Returned, but by information of Mr. Wm Findlay it cannot be found in the Surveyor General's Office & at the Request of Mr. Gully (he producing the Field Notes) I have Copied the Draught and made the Calculation
