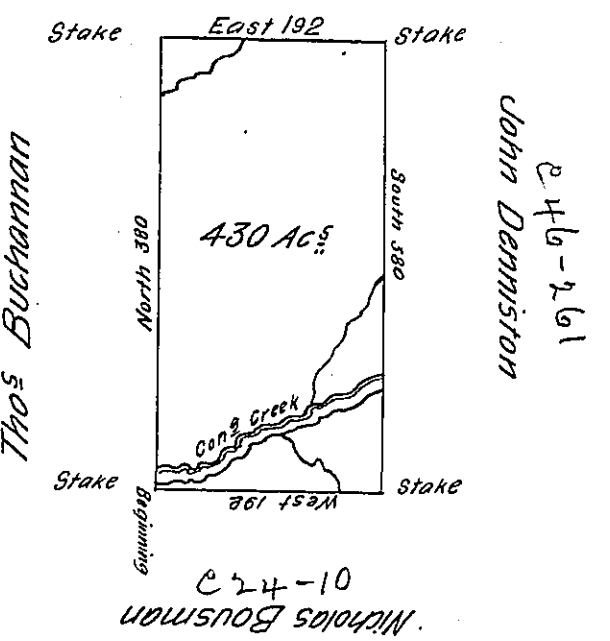

The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 12th day 1794 in pursuance of a warrant Granted to Charles Campbell for 400 acres of land. Dated the tenth day of February 1794. Adjoining Thomas Buchannan to the Eastward and and on the North Side of the Conaquesnessing Creek North and West of the River Ohio. Called Iron Bank. Containing four Hundred and thirty Acres together with the usual allowance of Six P^{ct} Cent for Roads
