



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 13th day 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Stephen Bayard for 400 acres of land dated the tenth day of February 1794 situate on the North side of the Conagnessing Creek where the Senago path crosses the said Creek north and West of the River Ohio called Locus containing four hundred and six acres and an half acre together with the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads
