The Figure in Red is a draft of a tract of land Situated in Borough of Lykens Dauphin County containing Fourteen acres and thirty Two perches and allowance of six per cent for roads. Surveyed 30<sup>th</sup> day of March 1888. It being a part of two tracts of land one containing 103 acres and allowance and the other 71 acres and 76 perches and allowance both of which tracts were originally surveyed in pursuance of two Warrants dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of November 1829 granted to Joseph S. Barnett.
