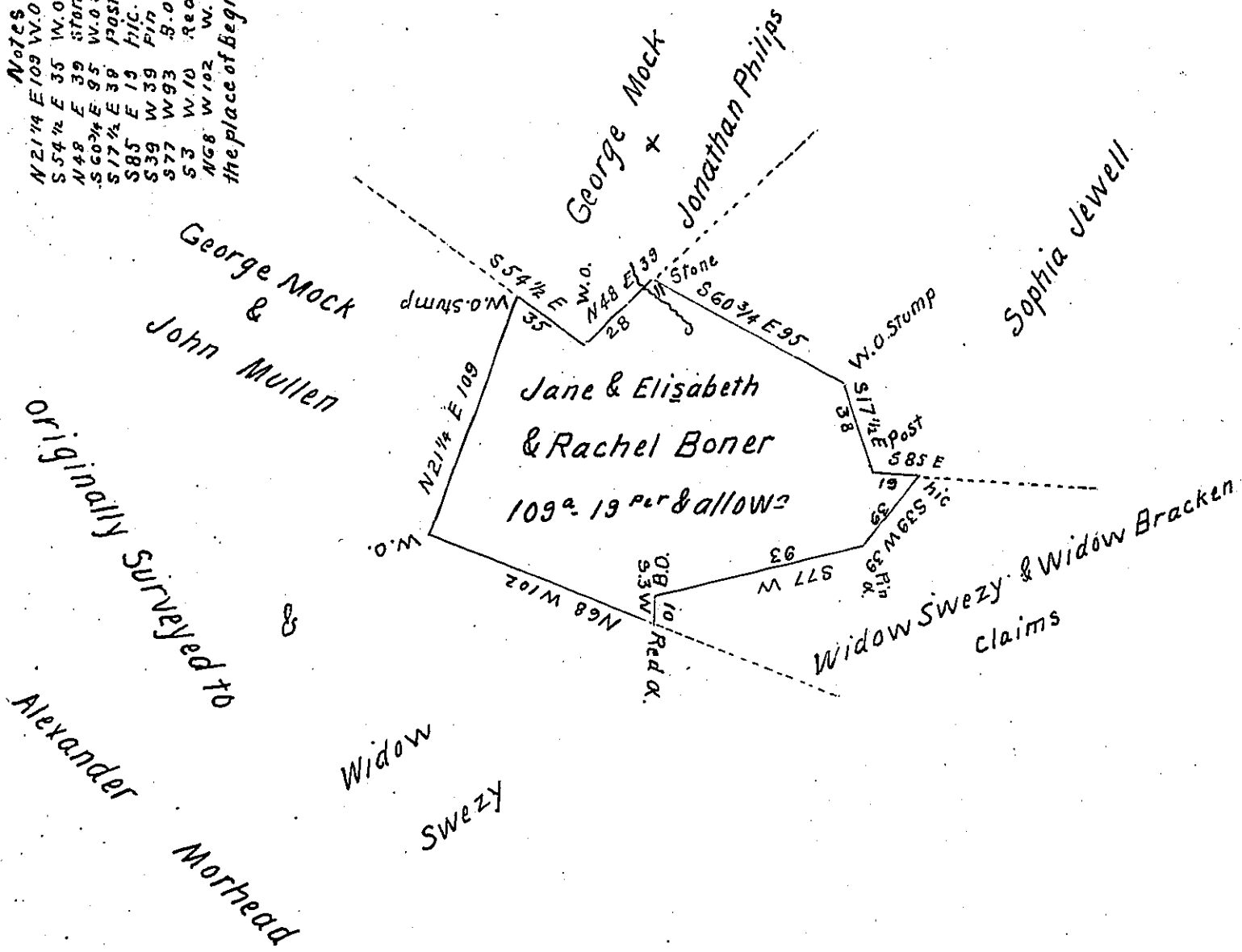

Sitate in Centre township Indiana County adjoining land of John Mullen George Mock Sophia Jewell and others as above described By Warrant dated the 21st day of May A.D. 1842.
