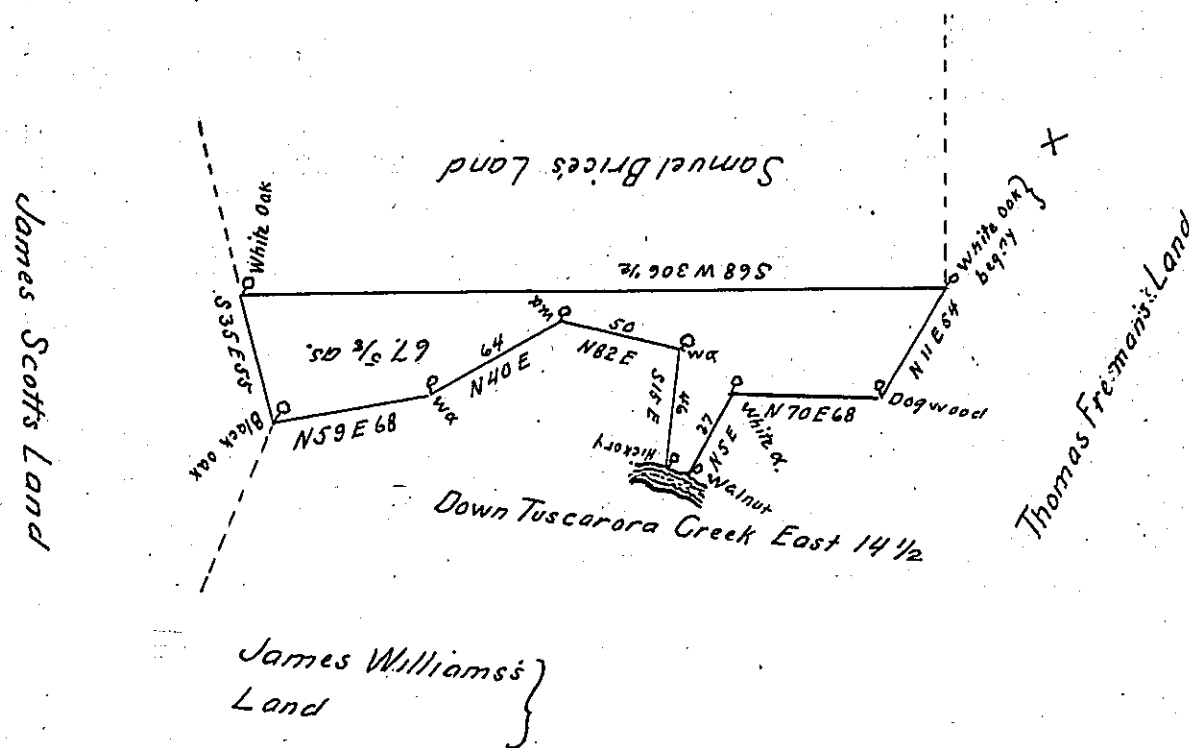


David Bowel 67.6 Acres



The Draught of a Tract of Land called ——— situate on Tuscarora Creek Cumberland County containing sixty seven Acres and one Hundred & eight Perches with the usual allowance of six Acres pr. Cent for Roads. Surveyed the 28th day of April Anno D^{omi}ni 1769 in pursuance of an Order of survey to David Bowel bearing date Philad^a the 23rd Day of March 1767 N^o 3120.
