Note — The greater portion of the above Survey includes part of a tract of land surveyed the 29th day of May 1832 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Simon Gratz dated the 31st day of May 1830 for 400 acres. — at the time I located Mr. Gratz's Warrant, Mr. Bressler's cleared land and improvement was not included in that survey, as represented by the five dotted lines on the above draft.
