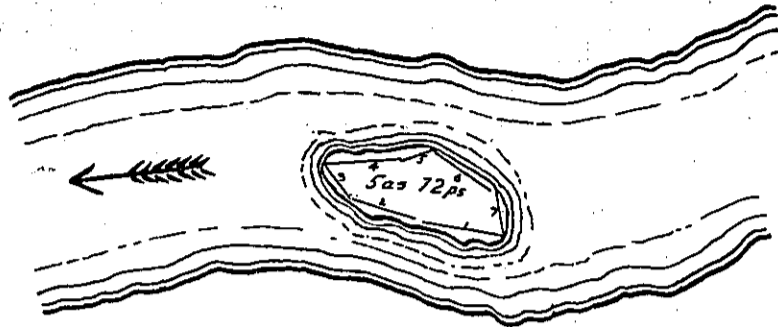

Draft of an Island situate in Cranberry township Venango County in the Allegheny river opposite to lands of Saml F Dale on the Southeast, and land warranted to James Gill on the north west side of the river, and known as the "Walnut Island." Survey'd 2^d January 1855 in pursuance of a warrant granted to W^m Bruner dated 2^d December 1851
