



Draft of an Island in the Susquehanna River in Oakland township Sus-  
quehanna County, opposite lands of F.F. Ward, and over the upper end  
of which the Erie Railway — passes. Surveyed the twenty second day  
of September A.D. 1863. for Edgar E. Barton in pursuance of a Warrant  
bearing date the twenty second day of April A.D. 1861. Containing  
five acres and one hundred & thirty two perches strict measure.

The Survey being made of all land four feet above low water mark.
