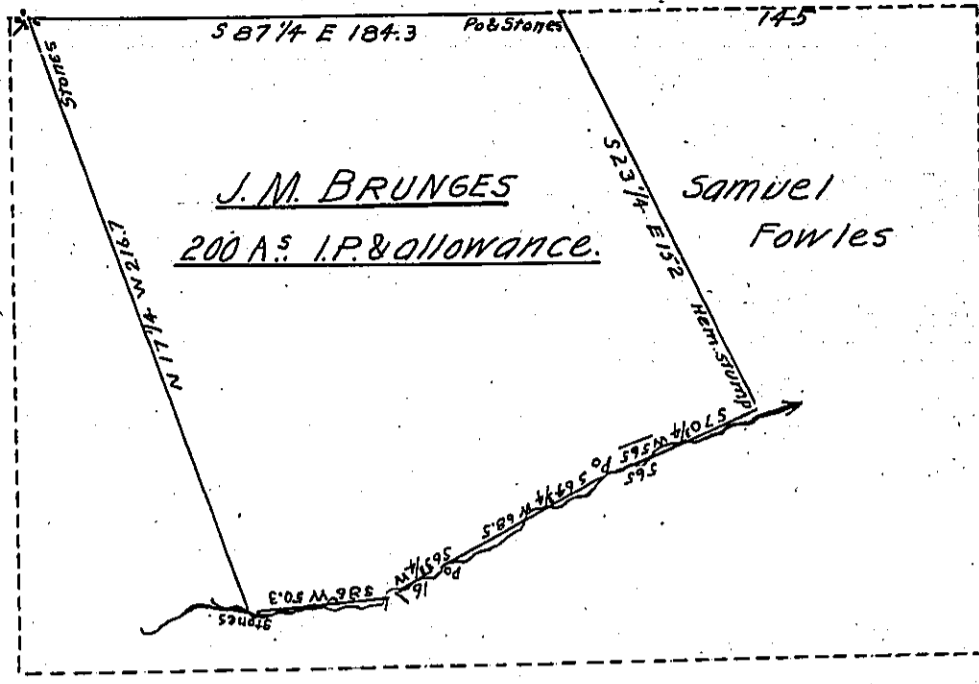


Jeremiah Fowles



Draft of a tract of land, situate in Eaton township, in the county of Wyoming, containing 200 acres 1 perch and allowance of six percent for roads &c surveyed for J. M. Brunges the 7th day of November 1870; it being a part of a larger tract of 439 acres 122 perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to Samuel Fowles dated 3^d day of September 1792.
