



Situate in Dublin Township Huntingdon County Containing one hundred and fifty acres and ninety one perches and allowance — Robert Surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> of November 1810 for Michael Traxelor and ~~John~~ Thompson and Divided between them agreeable to the above drafts. Note) this land was first surveyed on a warrant Granted to James Berry and William Adams bearing date the fourth day of december 1787 it then contained 288 acres and 133 perches and allowance and on the petition of James Berry the Board of Property at a meeting held the 30<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1803 did order a resurvey to <sup>be</sup> made on said Land Agreeable to which order it is now Surveyed and Returned — Containing 303 93/100 18 P. & allowance.
