



Situate in Paradise Township York County; containing Seven Acres, One hundred and forty six perches & allowance of six percent - part of a larger tract of 213 $\frac{2}{3}$ 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ & allowance. Surveyed by George Stevenson then D.S. on the 14th day of October 1754, in pursuance of two Warrants granted to Paul Burgett dated respectively, the 18th December 1751 & 19th May 1752, Said part divided off 18th December 1816.
Examined & returned 7th March 1823.
