



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Upper Milford Township
 in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania

 by the said Philip Sebold. The whole was formerly Surveyed
 and divided by Edward Scull. The above was now resurveyed
 according to the old Lines in Pursuance of the said Order
 dated the 27th June 1762 for the said Jacob Neel (al: Diehl)
 on the 24th July Anno 1769
