



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the Twenty Seventh day of February 1733 Surveyed to Lodwick Clapp a tract of Land Situate in Oley in the County of Philada Beginning at a post in the line of William Roberts land thence by the Same North Seventy Degrees West twenty one perches and by land of Peter Helton the same Course one hundred and fifty two perches to a post thence by the S^d Helton's Land North twenty Degrees East Eleven perches and by Land of Owen Richards the same Course one hundred & four perches & by Vac^t Land Eighty one perches to a Stone thence by Vacant Land South Seventy Degrees East one hundred & Seventy three perches to a post thence by Land of Benjamin Boone South twenty Degrees West one hundred & Ninety six perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing two hundred acres with the usual allowance of six P^{ct} = Surveyed April 20th 1734 By Nich^o Scull.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this fifth day of April 1904.
