



By Virtue of a Warrant from ye Hon^{ble} Proprietaries
 Bearing Date the Eighteenth Day March ADom/1737
 I have Survey'd and laid out unto Calvin Cooper in the
 Township of Pennsborough in the County of Lancaster
 on on the West Side Susquehanna Two hundred and three
 Acres of Land with allowance of 6 P Cent - Beginning
 at a Red-Oak (on the Top of a little hill) near Fishing Creek
 Thence South Sixty Seven Degrees Westerly Two hundred
 and Eighty one perches to a Post Thence South Twenty three
 Degrees Easterly one hundred and Twenty eight Pches to White
 oak North Seventy Six Degrees Easterly one hundred and six-
 ty eight pches to a White Oak Thence North Eighty eight Degre-
 es Easterly to a Spruce Tree by the S^d Creek Thence up the
 Same Thruersing the severall Courses there of Near about
 one hundred and forty six Perches to the place of Beginning
