



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being Part of a larger Tract of the same name situate on the Waters of Clearfield Creek adjoining Lands Surveyed for Thomas Rodney Benjamin Betterton and Alexander Stuart's Tract at the Chest and Land claimed by Patrick Nugent beginning a few Perches West of that Part of the old Trading Path leading from Frankstown to the Kittanning where the said Path leads up the rising Ground to the Chest in the County of Bedford containing two hundred and ninety nine Acres and the usual Allowance of six Percent for Roads &c Surveyed the 14th Day of June 1773 for Thomas Clousdale in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27th Day of April in the same year by
 Do John Lukens Esq^r Surveyor / Thomas Smith U.S. General of Pennsylvania &c.
