



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 15th day 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Nicholas Bausman for 400 Acres of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining William Irvine to the Eastward and on the South Side of Conoquenessing Creek including a part of Said Creek North and West of the River Ohio Called Wood Containing four hundred and thirty nine Acres together with the usual Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads
