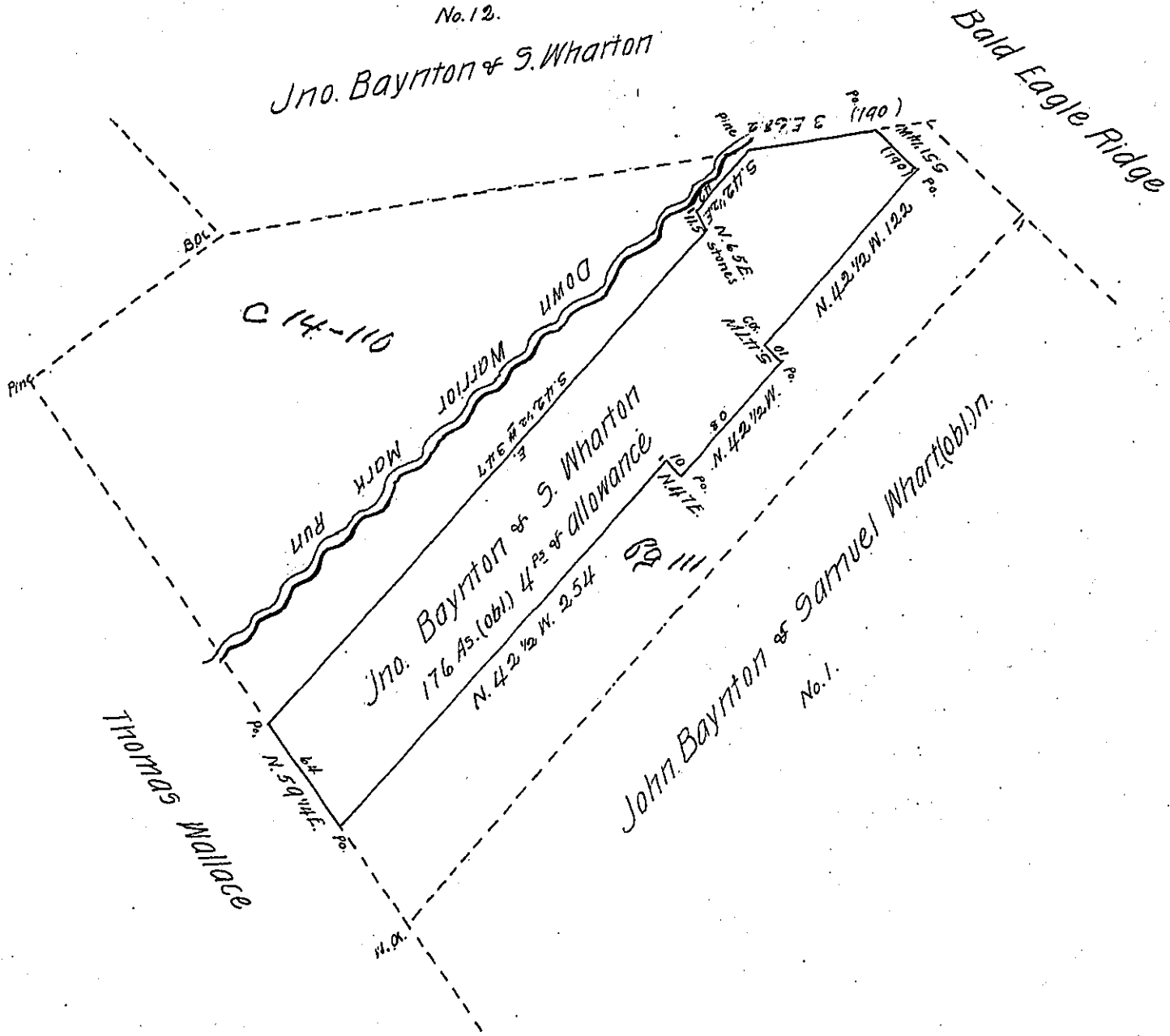

 and divided off from the Residue of the said tract the 8th day of May
