The above is part of a tract of land which was first surveyed the 4th day of September 1792. In pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Thomas Johnston dated the 25th day of April 1763 it then was said to contain one hundred & sixty one acres 78 perches & allowance. This part Resurveyed & Divided off from the Residue of the said tract the 19th day of January 1823.
