



Situate formerly in Wellam Township but now in Windsor Township in the County of York, containing as above set forth 161<sup>a</sup> & 57<sup>ps</sup> & allowance of six per cent &c. Originally surveyed for Joseph Bogle by George Stevenson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>a</sup> granted to the said Joseph Bogle bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September AD 1750. Resurveyed on the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> days of August 1804 by the settled lines of the then adjoiners for Peter Glassbrenner the owner. And now in Pursuance of an order of the Honourable Board of Property bearing date the 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 1812 granted to the said Peter Glassbrenner the above has been Resurveyed, calculated, examined & found to be correct the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May AD 1812 and Returned for Confirmation to Andrew Porter Esqr Surveyor General.
