



Situate in Reading Township Adams County Being part of a larger tract said to contain 215^a & all. Surveyed Feb^y 28th 1750 by George Stevenson D. D. by warrant to James Brown dated October 20th 1748 but now found to contain 233^a 126^{ps} & all. Divided off from the residue May 24th 1811 for the heirs of John Bushey deceased. Containing one hundred & fifty eight acres thirty three perches & all. The dotted line A was run by John Foray the D. D. for the line of Henry Myers's tract, but which interferes with the above tract & Myers's other tract which was surveyed on warrant to Henry Donnelly, obl. black line was agreed upon by the parties as above laid down
