



The above is a Draught of a Tract of Land Surreyd for Gabriel Cox in pursuence of a Certificate in the following words -

We the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented Land in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Gabriel Cox is entitled to four Hundred Acres of Land in Yohogania County on the Waters of Monong^a to include his actual Settlement made in the Year one thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty nine also a right in preemption to One Thousand adjoining thereto - Given under our hands at Coxes fort the twenty fifth day of January 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth
