



Situate on the Waters of Redstone Creek on the road that leads from Thomas Gist to Redstone Old Fort called Birds Road part in Union and part in Franklin Township Fayette County and Surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1785. In Consequence of a Certificate granted by the Commissioners for adjusting Claims to unpatented lands &c --- Of which the following is a Copy.

We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented Lands in the Counties of Monongalia Yohogania and Ohio and do hereby Certify that William Cracraft is intitled to Two hundred acres of land in the County of Yohogania on the Road leading from Gists to Redstone old fort to include his Settlement made in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy four.

Given under our hands at Redstone old fort the fifteenth day of December 1779  
in the fourth year of the Commonwealth.
