We the Commissioners for the adjusting Claims to Unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio do hereby Certify that Joseph Caldwell is Entitled to four hundred Acres of Land in the County of Monongalia On the Waters of the Monongalia River to Include his Actual Settlement made in the Year One Thousand Seven hundred and Seventy One.

Given under our hands at Cox's fort the twenty first day of February 1780 in the fourth Year of the Commonwealth.
