



A Draught of a small Island situated in the river  
 Susquehanna called Egg Island, about one quarter of a  
 mile above the course of Peach Bottom Ferry, about eighty per-  
 ches to the westward of Caldwell's Island, and about one hun-  
 dred perches to the Eastward of Cresimone Island in Little  
 Britain Township Lancaster County containing One  
 acre & one hundred & thirteen perches Acre Measure Survey-  
 ed the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December A.D. 1808 by Jesse Cornelius  
 By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the eighth Day of December  
 A.D. 1808 taken of Henry Reams field notes the 29<sup>th</sup> Day  
 of August A.D. 1812.
