Surveyor General

N.B the Survey above Stated was Regularly Surveyd unto Tho<sup>s</sup> Christy but by mistake the Return Appears to have been made on the ground on which Preserved Coolly was Surveyd the original Dt<sup>s</sup> have Tho<sup>s</sup> Christy marked on the Survey above Stated
