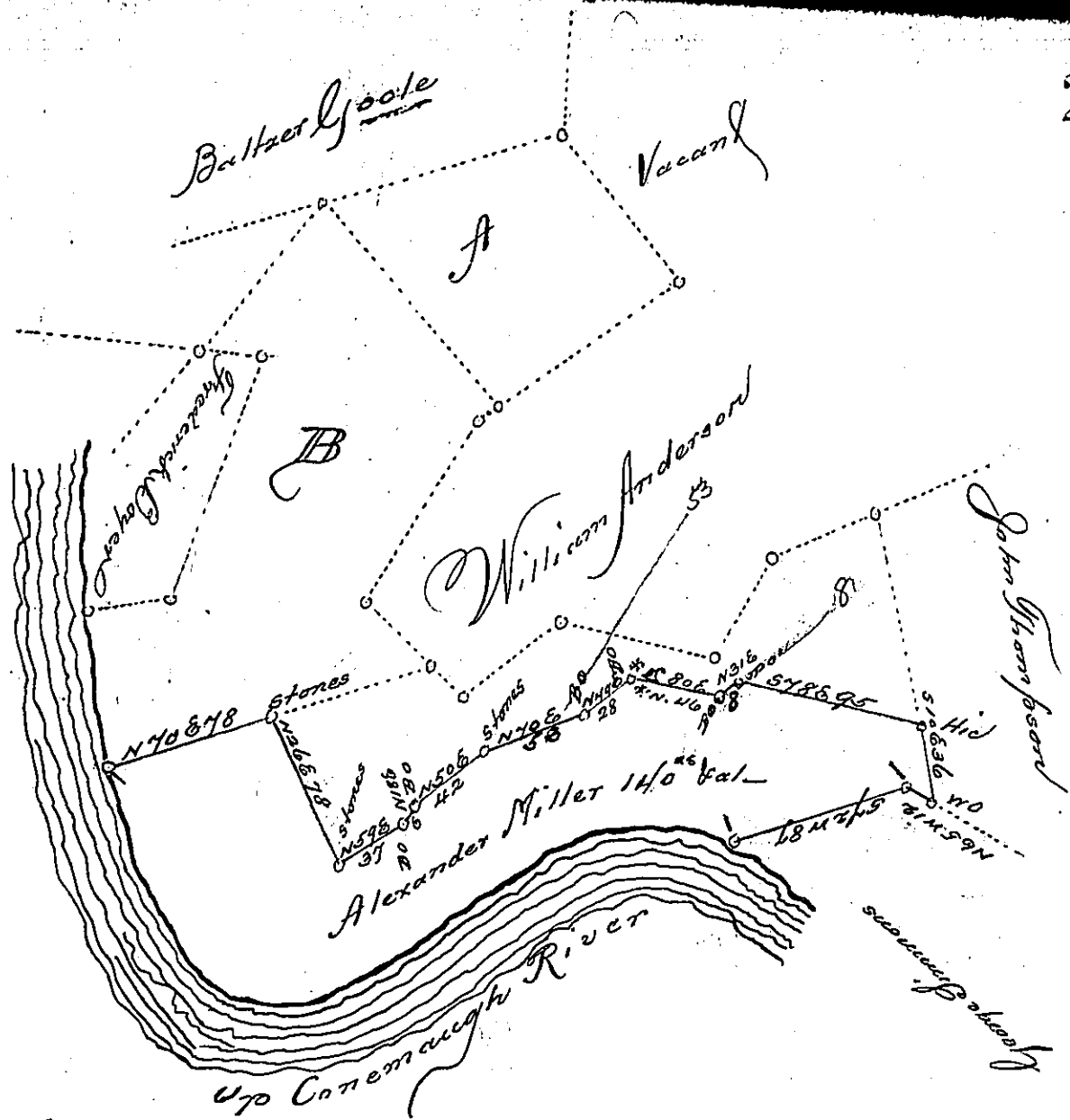

14th April 1832

Surveyed to Alexander Miller the above described track of one hundred and forty acres and allowed. Being part of a larger track surveyed to John Cummins on the 17th day of April 1787. By warrant of the 14th day December 1785 (as appears from papers in my office) it is situated in Conemaugh Township Indiana County and joining lands surveyed to Frederick Boyer, William Anderson, John Thompson and George Simmons.

N.B. that part of the Diagram marked with the letters A & B, appears from the papers to have been an alteration made on the same day for John Cummins. The drafts one both dated on the same day to wit 17th April 1787.
