



In pursuance of an order of the Surveyor General in date of November 1<sup>st</sup> 1826 and by virtue of a warrant dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1823 there was surveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of November 1826 unto Adam Hubley 309<sup>or</sup> 139<sup>ps</sup> of standard allowance situated then in Northern Chester County on a small branch of big Fishing Creek, but now in Mountain Pleasant Township Columbia County by William Montgomery D. S. and was resurveyed on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of December 1823 by virtue of an order of Resurvey dated the 6<sup>th</sup> day of December 1820. Resurveyed and examined and found the contents to be agreeable to the old lines 205. 26. and allowance after excluding the interference by
