



A draught of a part of a tract of land which was surveyed for Philip Counts and Anthony Altman in trust for the heirs of Adam Dipe deceased, in pursuance of a warrant dated December 4th 1784 containing one hundred and twelve acres one hundred and thirty six perches (it being the one half of the original tract) and the allowed proportion of six per cent for Roads &c. Situated in Hempfield Township in the County of Westmoreland, Surveyed October 6th 1826.
