



A Draught of a Survey lying on Dalebridge's Run (a branch of Buffalo Cr.) in Washington County, containing 259.159<sup>00</sup> ac. without any allowance, executed Dec. 2<sup>d</sup> 1785 in pursuance of a Certificate granted to J<sup>o</sup> Carpenter by the Commissioners appointed under the Government of Virg<sup>a</sup> to adjust y<sup>e</sup> Titles to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela, Y<sup>e</sup> & Ohio, which Certificate is in the list of those legally entered with the County Surveyor prior to the 26<sup>th</sup> June 1780.
