



A Drought of a Tract of Land called Scotland, = Situate on a small Branch emptying into the North Branch of White Deer hole Creek formerly in white deer Township Northumberland County Now Washington Township Lycoming County and Bounded as above. = Surveyed by Joseph J. Wallis the then D. S. on the 24th day of October 1788 for John Coats in Persuance of his warrant bearing date the 10th day of April 1775, = Containing Seventy five acres with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c. and at the request of the owner returned this 8th day Jan^y 1817 from a copy of the former survey remaining in the D. S. Surveyors office of Lycoming County.
