



Situate in Windsor township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 85^{2/3} 82 perches and allowance &c.^a Being part of a larger tract of Land which was originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to James Cross for 222^{2/3} dated the 14th day of December 1792 - Resurveyed and divided off from said larger tract on the 25th day of May 1802 and now at the request of James Cross Junr the same is calculated, examined, corrected and returned for confirmation this 22^d day of September 1827
