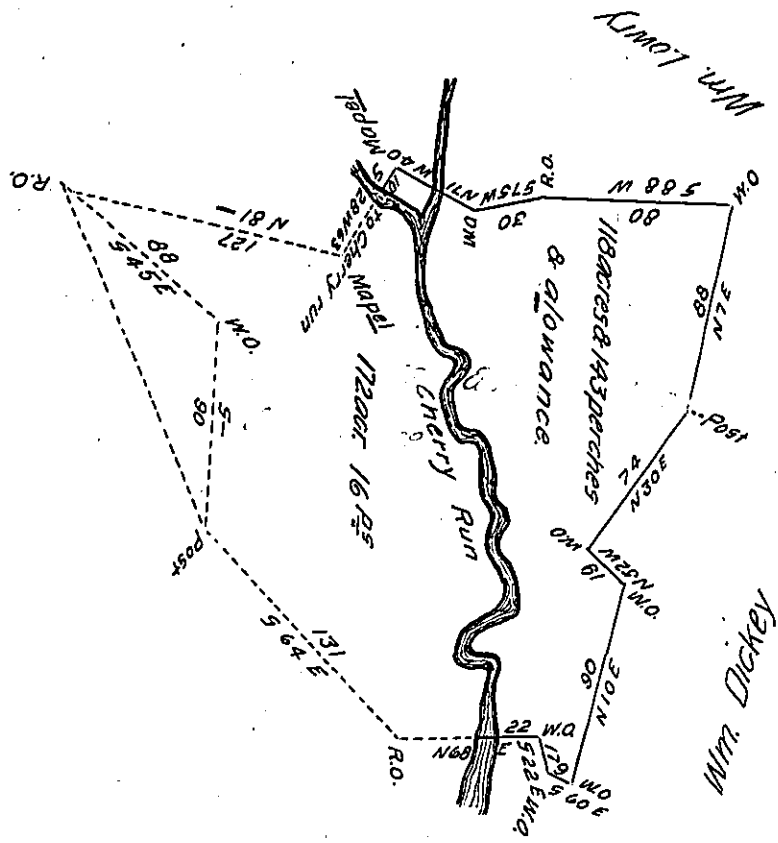

Survey the 8<sup>th</sup> of May 1822 to Jacob Libengood in Right of Moses Chambers the above described tract of one hundred and eighteen acres and one hundred and forty three perches and all<sup>s</sup> of six per cent for Roads &c. being part of a larger tract surveyed to said Moses Chambers by Warrant dated in 1786 Situate now in Centre Township Indiana County adjoining John McMullen Wm. Dickey and William Lowrey

Note- the original Warrant is not in my office but all the lines are well marked on the ground
