



Surveyed the above described tract of land on the 19th of February A.D. 1828 for John Curts Esq^r in pursuance of his Warrant dated the 26th of January 1828 containing one hundred and twenty five acres and eleven perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Situated in Chapman township Lycoming County in the old Purchase about three miles above the mouth of Young Womans creek including Vincents improvement consisting of a small cabin house and about thirty acres cleared land the improvement comenced about the year 1808.
