



Situate in Lattimore & Reading Townships Adams County Being part of a larger tract containing 250^a 123ps & all Surveyed May 25th 1811 by Warrant to Henry Donally dated September 10th 1750 Divided of from the residue same day for Henry Myers containing one hundred & fifty seven acres one hundred & twenty three perches & allw. The dotted line A is the line of Henry Myers's other tract as run by Henry Forsythe D 9 but which interferes with the above tract and also with land of the heirs of John Bushey the black lines as above laid down are the lines settled by the parties & now held to
