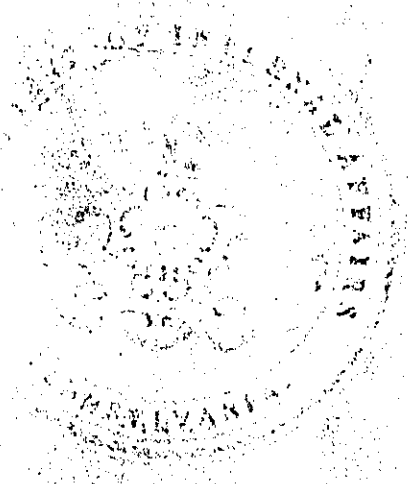
The above described Tract of land lays on the westerly end of Nittaney Mountain. Situate in Potter ^{Ferguson} ~~Patton~~ and Spring Townships in the county of Centre containing four hundred and five acres ninety five perches and allowance of six per cent & ca. Surveyed the 22nd day of April 1814 in pursuance of a Warrent to Cornelius Deal dated the 25th day of August 1812.

The improvement on the above described tract of Land consists of a Dwelling house and about two acres of clear land. Occupied by a man of the name of - Obrian and family, Tenant to Cornelius Deal - first improved in the month of August 1807.
