I do hereby Certify that the foregoing is a true copy of a survey recorded in the Survey <sup>book</sup> of ~~of~~ Stephen Gapen, remaining in the County Surveyors office in this county; except the 44 acres & 147 perches and allowance, embraced within the green shaded lines, claimed seperately by both John M. Thompson and E.A. Helmbold, both are now applying for Patents; - And further that it does not appear from the books and other Documents in my possession that the said tract of land has been surveyed or appropriated to any other person or persons, than the said applicants by warrants or other wise, except as afore-said.
