



Draft of a tract of land situate in the Township of Upper Tulpehocken in the County of Berks, containing One hundred acres, eleven perches, and the allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c., surveyed for Gabriel Feik, Emanuel Bergen John M. Degler and Jacob Pottenger, the seventeenth day of February 1872, being part of a larger tract of one hundred and eighteen acres ——— perches, and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Crist dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of March 1763.
