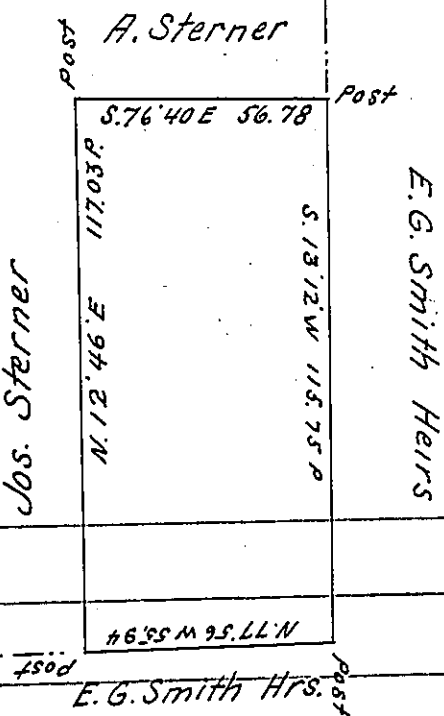

Smith Heirs the 8th day of June, 1904, it being part of a larger tract containing 301 ³/₄ acres, ————— perches and allowance, originally surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to James Cooper, dated the 20th day of January, 1774.
