



The above is a draft of a Survey made March 12th 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant granted Saml Clarke on the 4th day of Jan'y 1794. Situate North west of the Ohio River on the Waters of Beaver Creek. Adjoining Land granted to David Bradford - Called Red Bank - Containing 400 Acres together with the usual Allowance of 6 pr Cent &c.
