



The above is a Draught of a Survey made the 4<sup>th</sup> of February 1795 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Joseph Cooper wraugh for 400 Ac<sup>s</sup> of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on the Waters of Conaquesing Creek Adjoining Land Granted to David Claypole Called Hatfield. Containing four Hundred Acres and Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads.
