



The above is a draft of a Tract of Land which was Surveyed to Abner Coats on the 18th day of June 1803 by Virtue of his Warrant dated the 3^d day of December 1801. Containing four Hundred & Seven Acres and 84 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent & c. Including his Actual Settlement and Improvement Situate on the North & West of the Rivers Ohio & Allegheny & Conewango Creek in Conoquenessing Township and in Butler County.
