



A Draught of Two hundred and twelve acres and fourteen perches of land with six per Cent for Roads situate in Fermanagh Township in Mifflin county, which is part of a tract of land surveyed 11<sup>th</sup> April 1765 in pursuance of a Warrant to William Cochran dated 8<sup>th</sup> March 1765 said to contain 428<sup>3</sup>/<sub>10</sub>

Resurveyed and divided 16<sup>th</sup> June 1802 agreeable to an award of a Jury of men brought on the ground to make partition thereof and found to contain 424<sup>9</sup>/<sub>13</sub>

Examined 14 January 1813.
