erset County, late Londonderry Township Bedford Coun-
ty and surveyed the 11th day of December 1815 In pur-
suance of a Warrant Dated the 25th Day of September
1792 Granted to George Countryman for 150^a & is
returned for the owner to Comply with the Act to
authorise "the officers of the Land Office to accept re-
turns of Surveys and to direct Patents to issue,
where there is an excess of more than ten P Cent re-
turned passed the 13th day of March 1817"
