



Beginning at a post near the Bank of Lycoming thence up the same S. 89° W. 11 p. N. 36 1/2° W. 13 p. - N. 78° W. 40 p. - N. 7° W. 16 p. N. 41° E. 13 p. N. 50 1/2° E. 24 p. N. 89 1/2° E. 40.5 and N. 23 1/2° E. 47 p. - to a hemlock.

Surveyed the above tract of Land for Merrick Crandle on the 6<sup>th</sup> Day of August 1835 in pursuance of his warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of April 1833, Situate in Elkland township Lycoming County, Containing Fifty two acres and thirty five perches and the usual allowance of six Pr. Ct. for Roads &c.
