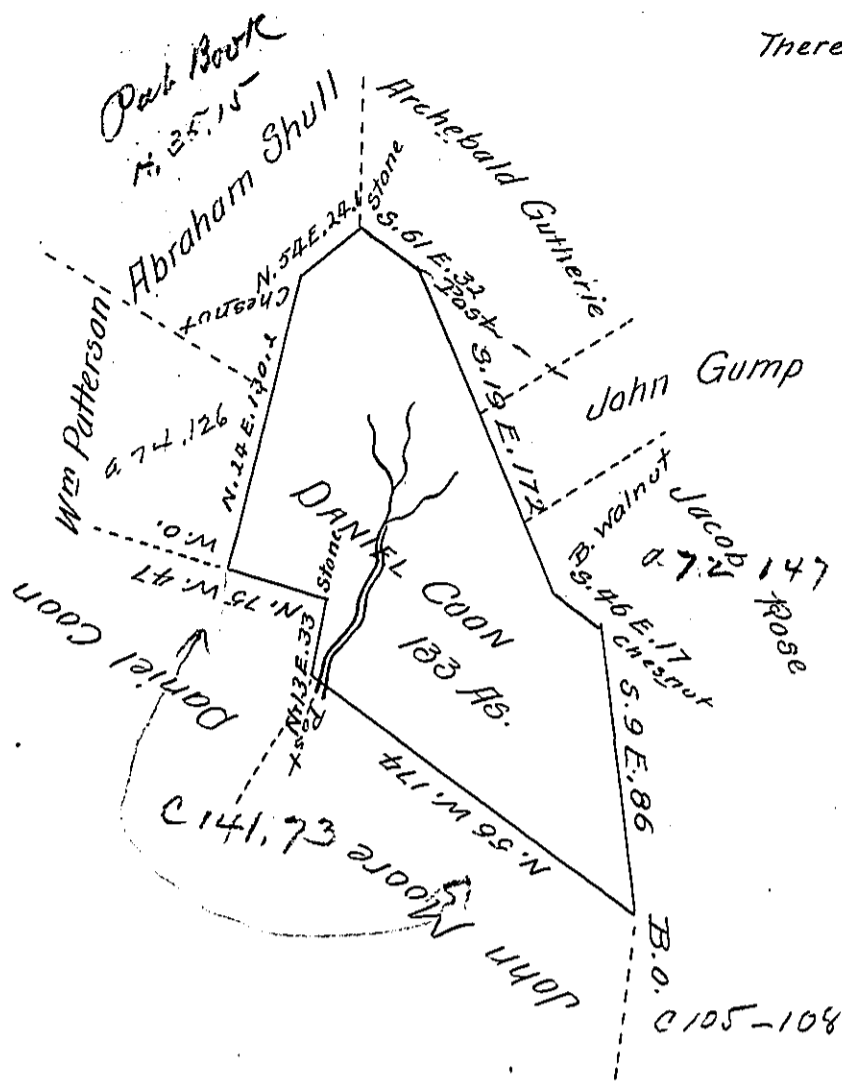


There are no adverse Claims
