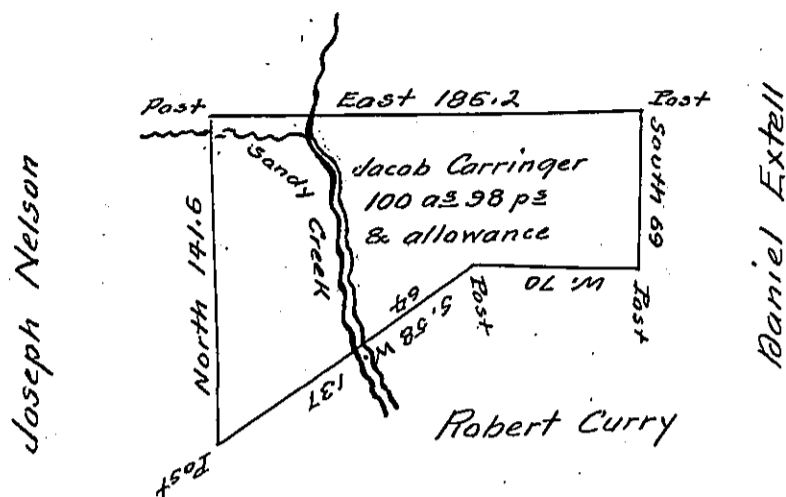

 ance of six per Cent for Roads
