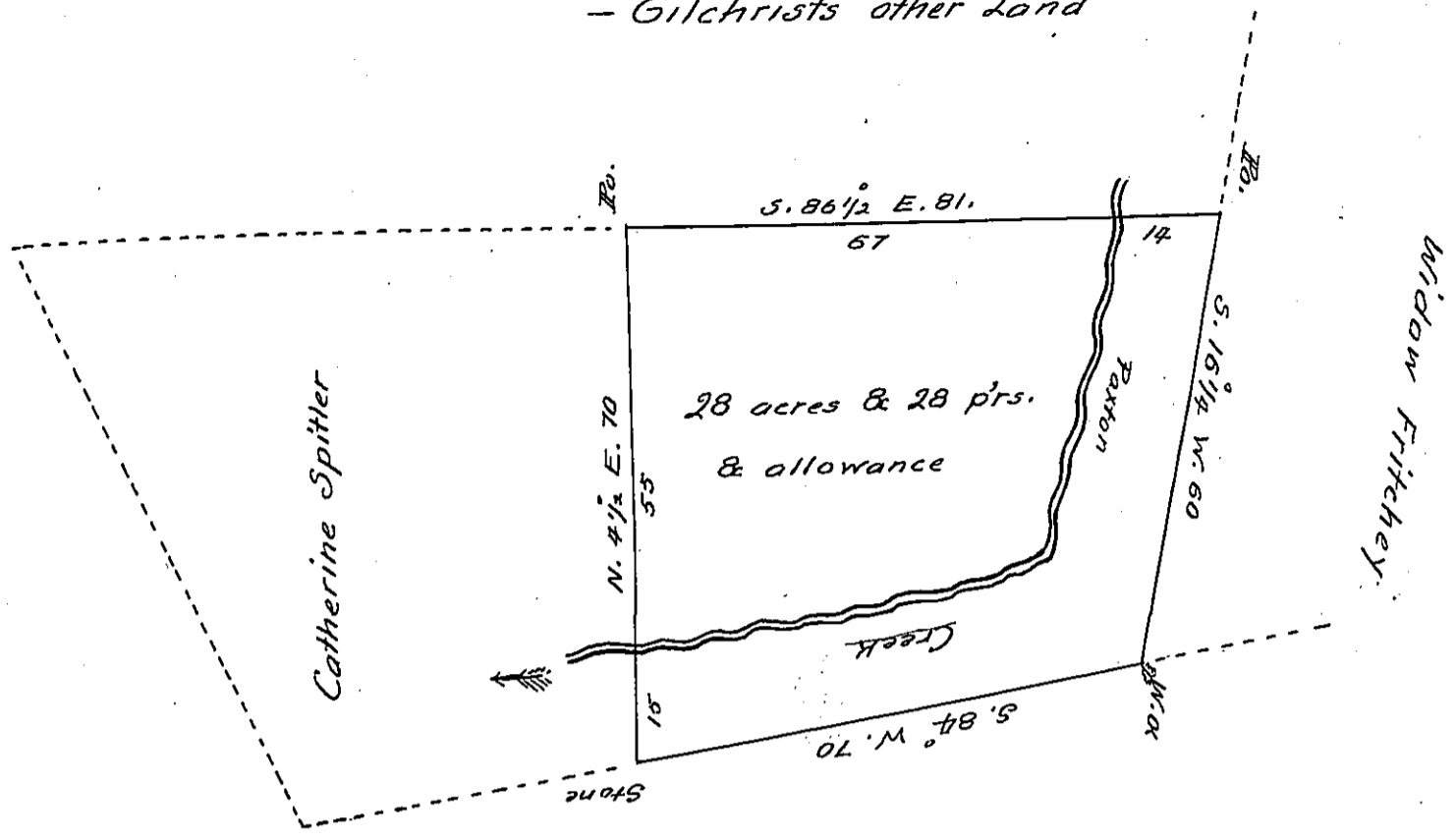


- Gilchrists other Land



Surveyed October 30th 1833 for Robert Gilchrist the above described tract of land containing twenty eight acres & twenty eight perches with allowance of six per Cent for roads &c. Situate in lower Paxton township Dauphin County being part of a larger tract of land granted by the Proprietaries warrant dated the 22d day of January 1752 to Mathew Cowden & John Gilchrist
