



Situate on Rasler's Run, a branch of Indian Creek, in Saltlick town-
 ship and County of Fayette, surveyed on the 12th & 13th days of November A.D.
 1841 in pursuance of a warrant granted to James C. Cumming for 230 acres
 dated on the 6th day of May AD 1841. There are cleared on this tract about 35
 acres, a log cabin and stable erected thereon and a family residing as ten-
 ants of said Cumming. It appears to have been settled or improved about
 40 years.
